Nolan Hendrickson (1976) was born and raised in Olympia, Washington. He attended the architecture program at California College of Art in San Francisco, and graduated from Evergreen State College in Olympia, Washington (2000). After moving to New York City in 2007, he began exhibiting regularly with Ramiken Crucible upon its inception in 2009. In 2017, he had a solo exhibition with Ramiken at Basel Statements in Basel, Switzerland, and mounted a large-scale exhibition of new work at Ramiken's Los Angeles space later that year. In September 2018, Hendrickson staged a solo show at Galerie Hussenot in Paris. He was awarded a grant from the Pollock-Krasner Foundation in 2019. Hendrickson lives and works in Brooklyn, New York.
